- 5/10 - Nicolet Technical College hosted the annual dual credit training day. Dual credit courses allow a student to earn college and high school credits by taking the course on the THS campus and being taught by THS instructors. Students earning credits are issued a college transcript demonstrating their academic standing. The training day is required of high school staff members that offer dual credit classes through Nicolet. Staff spent the day collaborating with their college counterparts reviewing curriculum and learning competencies, along with training on various topics needed to teach dual credit courses at a level that meets college standards.
