<u>Recommendation:</u> The administration recommends the adoption of the Bexar County JJAEP Memorandum of Understanding.

<u>Summary:</u> This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the Bexar County Juvenile Board and the Boerne Independent School District, grants BISD the ability to remove students that meet the specific criteria outlined in the MOU to the Bexar County Juvenile Justice Alternative Education Program (JJAEP).

The MOU allows BISD to place to place both out-of-county and in-county students in the Bexar County JJAEP. If the JJAEP reaches its maximum capacity of 250 students, then in-county students are given priority.

<u>Rationale</u>: Students are assigned to a JJAEP program as a result of violating Texas Education Code Chapter 37 listed offenses which include: 1) mandatory expulsion from their home school campus for serious infractions of the Student Code of Conduct, 2) discretionary expulsions for serious infractions that occur off-campus as well as other infractions of the Student Code of Conduct, or 3) are court ordered due to Title V offenses or probation conditions.
