Consider Approval of 2020 - 2021 - CPR Waiver

## SUMMARY:

This consent agenda item requests approval to apply for the CPR Waiver listed below for the 2020 – 2021 school year.

School districts and open-enrollment charter schools are required to provide instruction to students in grades 7 through 12 in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR). If seniors have not completed this requirement, a school district should request a waiver of the requirement from the Commissioner. This request is being made in accordance with the <u>Texas Education Agency's guidance dated February 10</u>, <u>2021</u>. This waiver from the CPR instruction requirement for seniors is being submitted due to COVID-19.
