Transitioning from RtI to MTSS

MTSS

Rtl

- academic Based
- focused solely on student response to instruction and intervention
 - reactionary to student data

- more cohesive/comprehensive with goal of meeting the needs of all learners
 - addresses academic **and** social, emotional, and behavioral development of children (Whole Child focus)
 - collaboration between general education and special education within each school, and between the school and the district office
- alignment of instruction and building teacher capacity

The "Other Side" of the Triangle



MTSS Reaches ALL Learners

- Differentiation at Tier I is just as important for those students needing enrichment as those students needing support
- If grade level standards are being met, further extension of the given skills can be targeted
- Extension and enrichment can be fluid based on student need
