## **FENTON HIGH SCHOOL**

#### 2016-2017

Senior students meet with their counselor during Bison Time and individually to complete the exit conference questionnaire. This survey is designed to provide information on our students plans upon graduation. It also provides some statistics in relation to their post-secondary planning. Students who plan to pursue a post-secondary education next year on a full or part-time basis is 89.2%. A total of 1425 college applications were submitted and resulted in a 71% acceptance rate.

Statistics from the Senior Exit Conference are based on self-reported information from students in a survey taken in April and May of 2017.

FAFSA statistics are provided from a partnership with the Illinois Student Assistance Commission.

350 graduating seniors were surveyed by their counselors as to their plans following graduation:

- 46.3% Attend a four-year college or university
- 42.9% Attend a community college or trade school
- 6.3 % Begin working and not attend school
- <u>2%</u> Undecided
- <u>1.7%</u> Join the Armed Services
- <u>.1%</u> Other
- A total of 333 graduates sent out 1425 applications for admission, 411 of these applications were denied.
- 69% of students of the class of 2017 are first-generation college students
- 90% of students attending college are attending college in Illinois and 10% of students are attending out of state.
- 35% of students reported earning a scholarship. The senior class as a whole reported earning \$1,494,567 in scholarships to use at the schools they plan on attending.
- 72% of students filed the FAFSA reported by ISAC
- 60% of students who filed the FAFSA qualify for the Federal PELL Grant
- 59% of students who filed the FAFSA qualify for the Illinois MAP Grant

Of the 333 students who submitted applications:

- <u>30%</u> submitted one
- <u>15%</u> submitted two
- <u>7%</u> submitted three
- <u>11%</u> submitted four
- <u>8%</u> submitted five
- 28% submitted six or more

182 graduating seniors who attended Blackhawk Middle School were surveyed by their counselors as to their plans following graduation:

- 47% Attend a four-year college or university
- 42.5% Attend a community college or trade school
- 6.6% Begin working and not attend school
- <u>2.8%</u> Join the Armed Services
- <u>1.1%</u> Other
- 0% Undecided
- A total of 173 graduates sent out 682 applications for admission which resulted in a 74% acceptance rate.
- Blackhawk graduates reported earning \$595,840 in scholarships to use at the colleges they plan to attend.

Of those submitting applications:

- 33% submitted one
- 16% submitted two
- <u>7%</u> submitted three
- 10% submitted four
- 8% submitted five
- 26% submitted six or more

98 graduating seniors who attended Wood Dale Junior High were surveyed by their counselors as to their plans following graduation:

- 51% Attend a four-year college or university
- 43.8% Attend a community college or trade school
- <u>2%</u> Begin working and not attend school
- <u>1%</u> Join the Armed Services
- <u>1%</u> Other
- <u>1%</u> Undecided
- A total of 93 graduates sent out 471 applications for admission which resulted in a 66% acceptance rate.
- Wood Dale graduates reported earning \$632,727 in scholarships to use at the colleges they plan to attend.

Of those submitting applications:

- <u>24%</u> submitted one
- 15% submitted two
- <u>8.5%</u> submitted three
- 1<u>3%</u> submitted four
- 8.5% submitted five
- 31% submitted six or more
