EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

Testing & Accountability

BISD has registered all Bandera High School students, and is ready for the final December administration of 2019 STAAR/EOC.

At-Risk/McKinney-Vento

Texas Education for Homeless Children and Youth (TEHCY) Annual Grant Recipient Update took place on 10/3/2019. BISD was in attendance, and we have learned the grant to Bandera ISD will continue for the 2019-20 school year. Grant availability beyond that date is yet to be determined.

Federal Programs

Bandera ISD is in the process of applying for the Title V Texas Rural Schools Grant. The Rural and Low-Income School program assists eligible LEAs in addressing local academic needs more effectively by giving them greater flexibility in the use of limited federal resources. Eligible LEAs are those with 20% or more of the children ages 5 through 17 years served from families below the poverty line. It is designed to address the unique needs of rural school districts that frequently:

- Lack the personnel and resources needed to compete effectively for federal competitive grants; and
- Receive formula allocations in amounts too small to be effective in meeting their intended purposes.
