

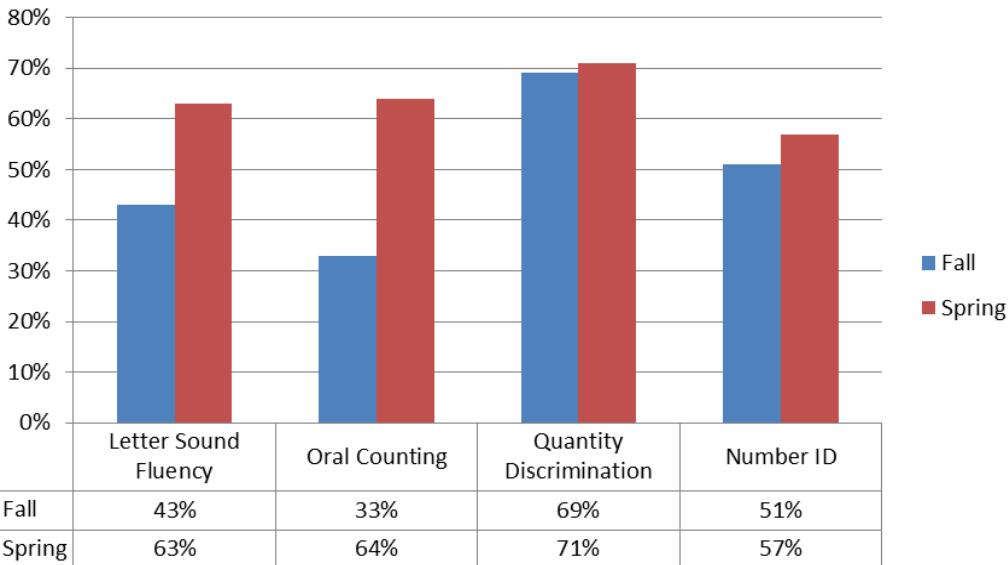

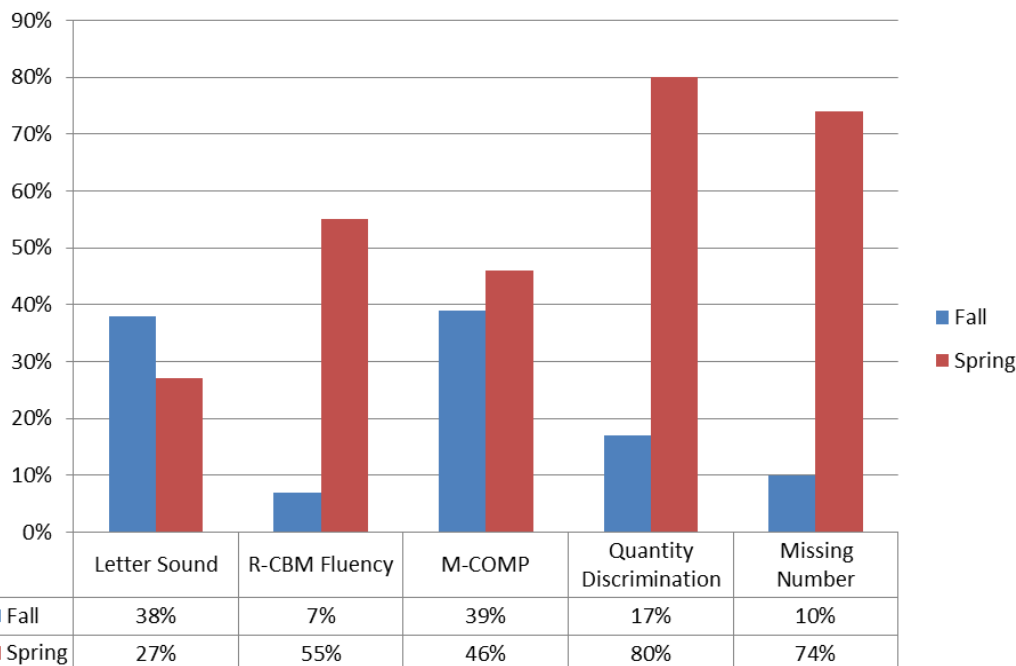

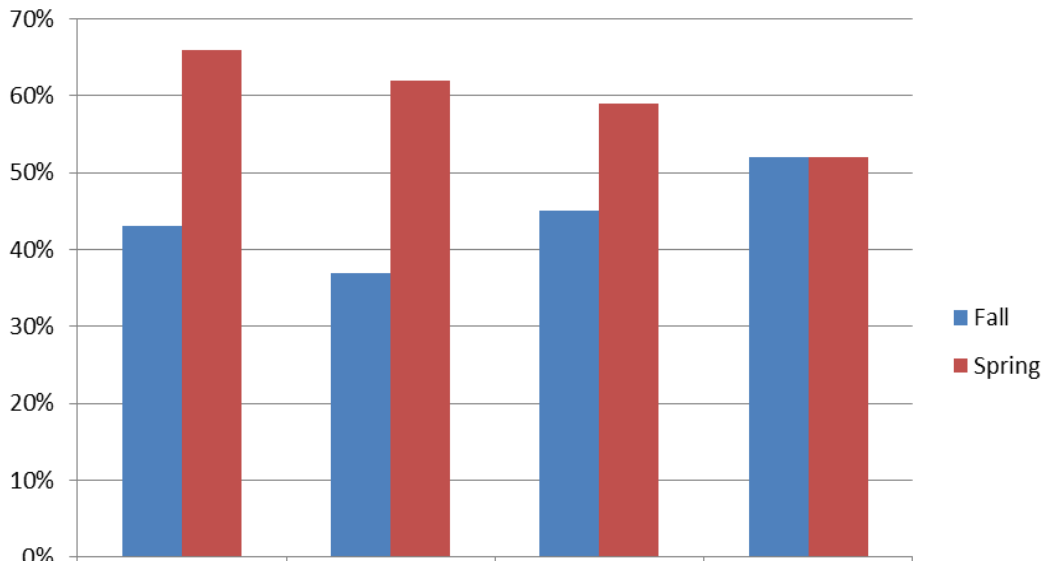

First Grade Benchmark Data

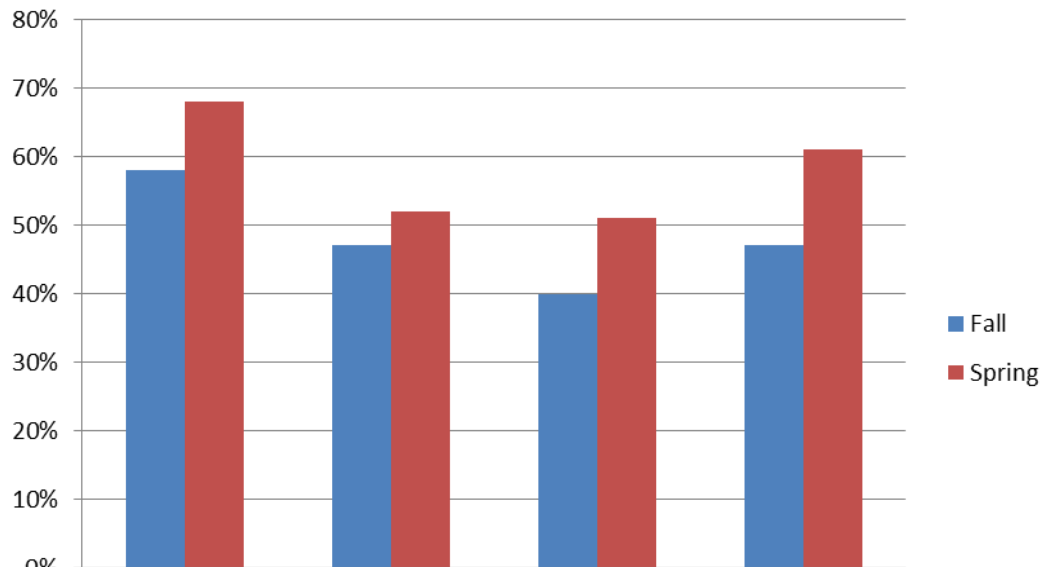

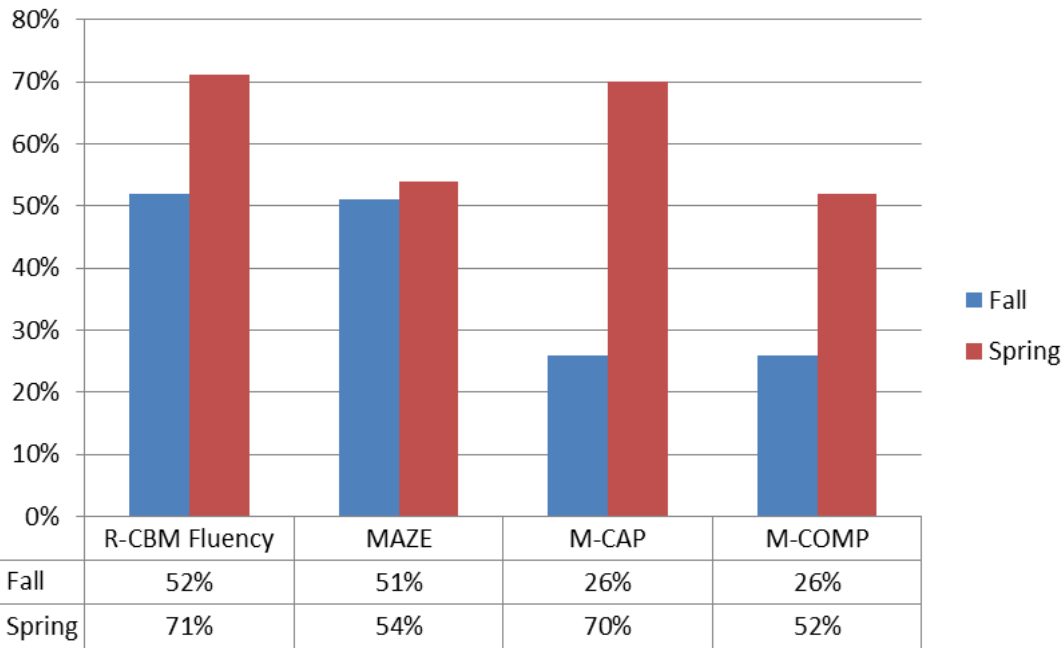

BIKES FOR BOOKS: Silver City Masonic Lodge #13 donated eight (8) bikes to be given away to students who read books between February 15th and May 19th. Each student had to read 10 books to be able to earn a ticket for the drawing. They could read as many books as they wanted to earn tickets. The 1st grade students read 2,210 books. The 2nd grade students read 1,290 books, up from 650 books last year. The 3rd grade students read 620 books, up from last year's 470 books, and 4th grade read 1,940 books, up from last year's 1,820 books. This year the students read 6,060 books compared to last year's total of 5,360 books. The students read 700 more books!! The winners were Elena Ozuna & Logan Barret (1st grade), Kate Johnstone & Nathan Marston (2nd grade), Neidy Ramirez-Gaytan & Todd Thatcher (3rd grade), Jocelynn Rosborough & Andrew Sanchez-Dominguez (4th grade).

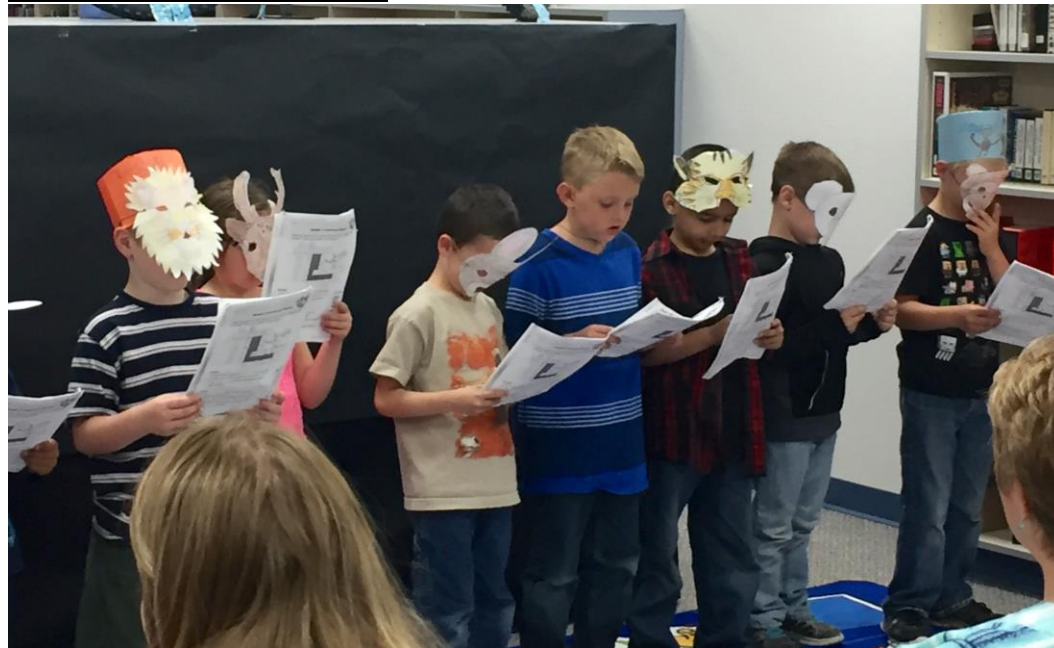
