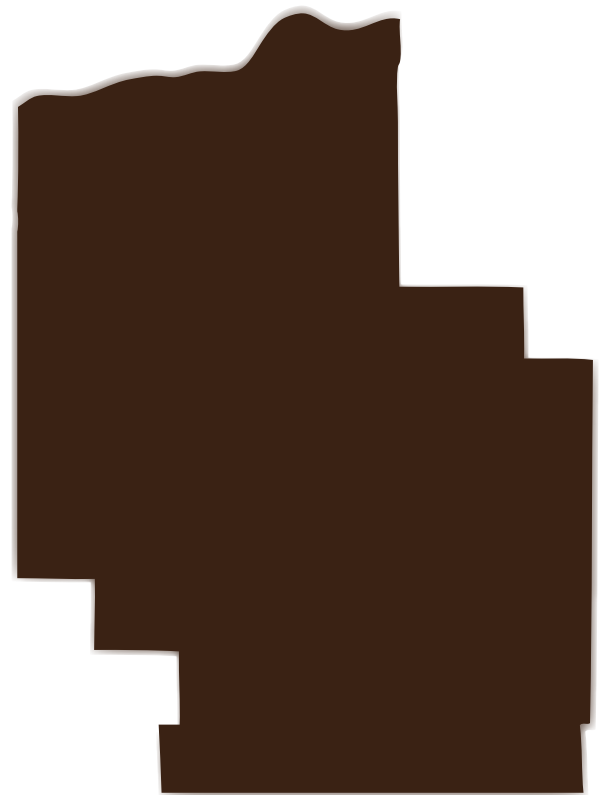

### **Community Health Improvement Partnership of Morrow County (CHIP) & Morrow County Local Community Advisory Council (LCAC)**

1. Focus is to support Health, Wellness, Nutrition, and Social Services needs in Morrow County.
2. Agenda is set around identifying needs of students, families, and citizens of Morrow County.
3. Goal is to use grant funds to address problem areas to improve the quality of life.

### **Morrow County School Health Advisory Council (SHAC) (meetings follow CHIP/LCAC meeting)**

1. Focus is to support Student Health, wellness, nutrition needs in Morrow County.
2. Agenda is set around looking at health survey data, identifying needs of students and planning next steps we should take in providing resources to improve student and family learning around nutrition, wellness and safety.
3. Goal is to collaborate and address problem areas to improve the quality of education in MCSD schools. Goal is to take action in planning events that support parent and child learning needs in Morrow County.

### **Morrow County Early Childhood Committee**

1. Focus is to support Early Childhood education needs in Morrow County.
2. Agenda is set around next steps we should take in providing resources to families, and pre K children entering Morrow County.
3. The district has identified and prioritized horizontal alignment Pre K-to Kinder, READY Program, and Parenting Courses such as Abriendo Puertas/Opening Doors in every community.
4. Goal is to collaborate and utilize grant funds to address parent and child learning needs in Morrow County - Lack of funds is an issue.

### **Morrow County Local Public Safety Coordinating Councils**

In 1997, Oregon lawmakers enacted legislation that required counties to convene local public safety coordinating councils (LPSCC) that would, at a minimum, develop and recommend to the County Board of Commissioners a plan for the use of state resources to serve the local offender population.

1. Focus is to use state and local resources to identify needs, serve, and support, local offender population of Morrow County that is at least 15 years of age and less than 18 years of age.
2. Agenda is set around the coordination of community-wide services involving prevention, treatment, education, employment resources and intervention strategies around Morrow County.
3. The goal is to coordinate local criminal justice policy among affected criminal justice entities.
