

Community Health Improvement Partnership of Morrow County (CHIP) & Morrow County Local Community Advisory Council (LCAC)

- 1. Focus is to use state and local resources to identify needs, serve, and support, local offender population of Morrow County that is at least 15 years of age and less than 18 years of age.
- 2. Agenda is set around the coordination of community-wide services involving prevention, treatment, education, employment resources and intervention strategies around Morrow County.
- 3. The goal is to coordinate local criminal justice policy among affected criminal justice entities.
