EBB – OK Sept 2011	Integrated Pest Management – note: We have 2 policies (EBB and EBBC) that are the same and both are current. Delete EBBC and retain EBB.	REQUIRED. Existing policy is current.
EBBB–REVISED Oct 2013	Injury/Illness Reports	REQUIRED. HB 3045 requires, effective July 1, 2013, that districts have a reporting policy for injuries/illnesses that occur to employees during the actual performance of a duty. Committee Decision: Revise per OSBA.
EBCB– REVISED (version 2) Oct 2013	Emergency Drills	RECOMMENDED. HB 2789 requires instruction and two drills on “safety threat” in addition to other required emergency drills. Changes language for earthquake procedures to “drop, cover, and hold”. Clarifies time requirements. Committee Decision: Revise per OSBA.
ECAB-REVISED Sep 2011	Vandalism/Malicious Mischief/Theft	OPTIONAL. Allows a reward to be offered for information regarding vandalism/theft. SB 800 Section 15 revoked the right of district’s to withhold grade reports, diploma and records of students pursuant to ORS 339.260. Committee Decision: Revise per OSBA.
EDDA – NEW Nov 2008	Sustainability	OPTIONAL. Provides a structure for districts to implement a sustainability policy that encourages the development of “green” schools. Committee Decision: Add per OSBA.
EDDA – AR – NEW OCT 2008	Sustainability Management System	OPTIONAL. Provides additional guidance on the implementation of a sustainability policy. Committee Decision: Add per OSBA.
EEA – REVISED Feb 2012 and Sept 2012	Student Transportation Services	REQUIRED. SB 3590 modified the seat belt requirement. In 2012, the policy was reviewed in its entirety, adding language about pre-school children with transportation as a related service and Type 10 buses. Removed was language pertaining to transportation requirements for a school in NCLB Corrective Action since Oregon has a waiver from this requirement. NCLB Persistently Dangerous transportation language remains in place. Committee Decision: Revise per OSBA.
EEAC –REVISED Feb 2012	School Bus Safety Program	REQUIRED. Same changes to seat belt requirements as indicated above. Committee Decision: Revise per OSBA.
EEACC-NEW	Student Conduct on School Buses	REQUIRED. Clarifies behavioral expectations for

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Sept 2012		students on standard school buses and Type 10 activity buses. Committee Decision: Add per OSBA.
EEACD-NEW Sept 2012	Use of District Activity Vehicle for Student Transportation	REQUIRED. Clarifies requirements for use of district activity vehicles. Committee Decision: Add per OSBA.
EEAE – NEW Feb 2012	Student Transportation in Private Vehicle	RECOMMENDED. Clarifies requirements for students transported in private vehicles. Committee Decision: Add per OSBA.
EEBAA – NEW Feb 2012	District Vehicles/Seat Belts/Child Safety System	OPTIONAL. Addresses requirements for drivers of district vehicles to wear seat belts and take responsibility that seat belt requirements are met. Committee Decision: Add as per OSBA.
EFA – REVISED Feb 2012	Local Wellness Program	REQUIRED. Child Nutrition law was reauthorized in 2010 as the Healthy, Hunger-Free Kids Act (Public Law 111-296, Section 204) making a wellness policy a requirement of the district’s nutrition program. Adds specific requirements to various components of a wellness plan. Note: Compliance with PE instructional hours is required for the 2017-2018 school year. Committee Decision: Revise per OSBA.
EFA-AR REVISED Feb 2012	Local Wellness Program	OPTIONAL. Our AR is very different and more specific than OSBA recommendation. It was developed to align with the original required components of a Wellness Plan. Committee Decision: Revised with input from Michael Morris and David Marshall.
EFAA –REVISED May 2011	District Nutrition and Food Services	REQUIRED. Child Nutrition law was reauthorized in 2010 as the Healthy, Hunger-Free Kids Act (Public Law 111-296, Section 204) making revisions to language. Existing policy was moved to the AR. Committee Decision: Revise as per OSBA
EFAA-AR - MOVED May 2011 and Feb 2012	Reimbursable School Meals and Milk Program	REQUIRED. Moved current policy EFAA to this AR. Clarifies pricing structures, drinking water availability, and administrative tasks such as meal tickets and meal charges. Committee Decision: Revise as per OSBA and input from Michael Morris
EGACA – NEW Feb 2013	Cell Phones	OPTIONAL. Provides guidance when the district issues cell phones or reimburses for the use of a personal cell phone. Committee Decision: Do not adopt
EGACA-AR – NEW Feb 2013	Cell Phones	OPTIONAL. . Provides guidance when the district issues cell phones or reimburses for the use of a personal cell phone. Committee Decision: Do not adopt
