We had one district vehicle that had a recall on it and we sent it to Northern Ford last week it should be done.

Mechanics been busy repairing seats, checking and repairing any mechanical defects that they come across. Both front windshield and the stop sign have been replaced in bus#007. The brakes on Bus #201 and #150 have been replaced. Bus#5 had all the back tires changed.
