Our seven school board members spend countless hours volunteering to provide the highest level of education for our students and a quality work environment for staff. Before making a decision, NKN School District's Board of Directors ask, "What is best for students?" The NKN school board, with thirty-three years of accumulative service as board members, make important decisions based on the very best for students. Board members attend monthly school board meetings, participate in trainings, serve on committees, negotiate with employee groups, partner with the superintendent during "Coffee & Conversation" opportunities, and constantly engage with parents, students, and staff.

This school year, in addition to the daily responsibilities of board members, the Board is actively engaged in the Integrated Guidance work, the writing of a long-range Continuous Improvement Plan (CIP), and the new superintendent search.

School board members represent their fellow citizens' views and priorities in the complex enterprise of maintaining and operating the Neah-Kah-Nie School District. Each board member is elected to a four-year term by registered voters. They also reinforce the principle of local control over public education, which is an important, highly valued aspect of education in Oregon.

The Key Work of the NKN School Board is:

Vision

- Create district and community consensus on achievement objectives
- Clearly define expectations for what sudents should know and be able to do

Standards

- Establish clear standards for student performance
- Base standards on an external source that has credibility in the community

Assessment

- Tie assessments to established standards
- Use multiple, ongoing assessment measures

Accountability

- Measure the performance of all school staff members, administrators and the school board itself against student achievement objectives
- Continually track progress and publicize the results

Alignment

- Align resources to ensure students meet standards
- Include the community in the review of the district's budget and management process

Climate

- Create a climate that supports the philosophy that all children can learn at high levels
- Empower staff to meet the needs of all students

Collaborative relationships

 Build collaborative relationships with employee groups and political/business leaders to develop a coalition that advocates for student success

Continuous Improvement

- · Commit to continuous education and training on issues related to achievement
- Use data on student achievement to set priorities for allocating resources
- Adjust the strategic plan on the basis of data and community input
