SUBJECT: FINANCIAL REPORT NARRATIVE

FY 2019 BUDGET REVISION – This is presented for your approval.

E-RATE —We have posted our Form 471 this month for our Internet Services for next year. Although this is based on a continuing contact with GCI, USAC will likely send questions in the next couple of months since they have different individuals reviewing the applications every year. Next year will be our 3rd year of a 3 year contract with the option to renew for a year two times. I am recommending that we go back out to bid next year so we can determine if costs have come down and if other vendors may want to bid the Internet services ... again at a lower cost.

<u>TIMBER RECEIPTS</u> – An email has been sent to the Alaska Dept. of Commerce and Community & Regional Affairs to determine when we can expect our FY 2019 Timber Receipts. They have responded that sometime the end of February they receive notice from the US Forest Service and then it takes a couple weeks to receive the actual deposits.

<u>Quarterly Reports</u> – All grants reimbursements except two have been submitted. W2's and 1099's have been issued and also submitted on line to Social Security and IRS. Bank Reconciliations are all current and balanced.

FY 2020 BUDGET – The projected revenue this early, based on a status quo Base Student Allocations of \$5,930 is as follows:
