For the Business Section:

Appoint Two Parents to Fill the Two Parent Seats for SY26

The Governance Committee recommends that the Board appoint Colleen Hansen to fill a Parent Seat beginning July 1, 2025 and ending June 30, 2026. Her expertise in some ongoing areas (the expansion and the Academic Excellence Committee) would be invaluable to have for another year.

Although we had another very qualified former board member also interested in serving, the GC further recommends that the Board appoint Lisa Gomez to the second Parent Seat beginning July 1, 2025 and ending June 30, 2026. The GC feels that her HR background and other expertise would be an asset to the work of the Board.

Note on the Consent Agenda: The Governance Committee is responsible for making recommendations for people to serve on the Friends of Nova (our "landlord"). The FoN board must be at least 4 people and not more than 7. [Jesse Prins (serving indefinitely as a part of his position at Nova Classical), Brian Lapham, and Paula Roberto are continuing members.] Jyotstna Sivaguru is a Nova Classical parent with a background in architecture, working with large non-profit clients and government entities, and working

on projects of various scales. The GC feels she would be an excellent addition to the FoN board.
