RE: 2019 – 2020 Enrollment Update

The budget process for the 2019 – 2020 fiscal year starts with an update on the enrollment target for next year. After the enrollment target is established administration and staff will accept, deny, or waitlist open enrollment applications with a goal of getting as close to the target as possible.

After the target is established administration will generate a preliminary general fund revenue and expenditure projection. At that time options & scenarios to address a projected budget surplus/shortfall will be identified. The enrollment target and 2019-20 assumptions will be discussed tonight. 2019-20 options & scenarios will be discussed on March 7 and 28.

The following enrollment target per building was established using previously established School Board guidelines including Metro ECSU regionwide class size trends.

Administration recommends setting the K-12 enrollment target for the 2019-20 school year at 3,295.

The analysis above assumes that 21 students currently attending who are open enrolled in 2019-20 are accepted and attend. The enrollment target includes estimates for non-acceptance and grade level attrition that happens throughout the year.
