## Partnerships

- Crystal City ISD met with superintendent regarding the potential of Early College High School or Academy model for the district. The ISD will research further into the details and try to see if it will be feasible for next fall.
- Medina Valley ISD met with superintendent to renegotiate our lease for the Castroville facility and discussed the possibility for an Early College High School for their district.

## Enrollment

Cabinet and key stakeholders met with individuals from Civitas to demo a college course scheduler software. The software assists students in preparing course schedules. We understand that we have to keep improving our services to students, yet we have very limited resources. A foundation is providing grant funds that will cover the first year cost, half of the second year cost; our initial investment is \$5,000 for installation. At year 3, the cost is \$20,000 (1/3 of the cost to hire one additional advisor)
