	Background Information:	Cooperative (R10M	ucation Service Center Multi-Region Purchasing MRPC) will organize, administer, tabulate, advertise, d act as a coordinating center for all food purchasing				

bids. Authority for such services is granted by section 8.053 of the Texas Education Code.

The goal of the R10MRPC is to offer the member districts substantial savings on specific commercial food items, non-food items, and USDA commodity processed items. By volume purchasing, districts are able to save more money than bidding as a single district.

The R10MRPC offers several formal, legally procured bids to assist districts with their food purchasing needs. There is no fee to join the co-op. An annual Interlocal Agreement is required which provides access to any and all bids procured by the co-op.

We began using this cooperative for the 2023-24 school year and have been very satisfied with their services.
