Report Information:

A. Enrollment

Enrollment has come in this fall at a higher rate than anticipated. The district was looking for a total increase across K-12 of 99 students to a projected 2013-14 enrollment of 4,809. Thus far, the increase through September 9th has yielded a total student enrollment of 4,876. Deputy Superintendent Lynn McKinney is continuing to monitor the enrollment numbers with the campus principals.

The district has commissioned Templeton Demographics to perform a new ten-year demographic projection of AISD looking at each campus by grade level. This information is anticipated back by late October/early November and a report will be made to Trustees at the first available meeting after the information comes back.

B. School Start

The school year began with a very smooth start. This is in large part due to the hard work the principals and their teams put in to prepare for the 13-14 school year. The campuses appeared to have picked up where they left off with instruction of students beginning in earnest the very first day of classes.

It is important to note the hard work of Directors Leonard Torres, Patty Wilhite, Brooks Moore, and Steve Bond. Their respective teams and the thoughtful preparation they put in place made the first days of school look easy.
