Subject: Franklin High School Flexible Furniture Purchase

I am requesting the support and purchase of Franklin High School's Flexible Furniture plan to provide new and contemporary learning spaces in their building. This is a follow-up item from the Study Session of March 26, 2018, and as a refresher it is a Phase III purchase, targeted to secondary furniture replacement from the Bond funds of 2013. Each high school was afforded \$75,000 and the autonomy to develop, with their staffs, a plan of furniture replacement that would be inclusive of all students and teachers with the goal of establishing collaborative learning areas, enhanced by these flexible furniture options. The administration at Franklin has targeted three areas within their building to include the Career Information Center, Computer Lab 501, and large group Room 509. Each area is designed for small group work stations, as well as independent areas for use with personal devises, laptops, Chromebooks. The Lab 501 plan will incorporate approximately two-thirds of the desktop computers currently in that lab.

The administration of Franklin High School has considered several furniture vendors and has selected Interior Environments for their furniture revitalization effort. The total expenditure for this request is \$73,142.
