**Personal Use**

Telecommuni-  
Cations Devices  
and Other Devices

The District shall permit the restricted use of personal cell phones and/or personal paging devices. A student shall not have a personal telecommunications device on visible use display or in operational mode at school during regular hours. During any state assessments, all personal cell phones shall be turned in to the test administrator and be in the "off" position.

Any electronic device that rings, beeps, vibrates, or otherwise indicates the receiving of a signal during school hours shall be confiscated.

Extracurricular  
Activities

Announcements, programs, bulletins, or posted signs shall direct the audiences on the restrictions and etiquette required to prevent distractions or interruptions for after-school activities on or off school property.

Penalties

A student who violates this policy shall be subject to established disciplinary measures. Authorized District employees shall confiscate any personal electronic devices found on school campuses during school hours that are in violation of Board policy.

*Notification*

Parents shall be notified within two school days after the personal paging device or cellular phone is confiscated. Notification shall also be made to the paging company whose name and address appear on the device.

~~*Release of  
Property*~~

~~Personal paging devices and cellular phones may be recovered by the legal parent or guardian from the administrator at the student's campus. There shall be a \$15 administration fee to release the property.~~

~~Any device that has not been claimed by the legal parent or guardian at the end of 45 calendar days after confiscation may be claimed by the vendor. The vendor shall present documentation of ownership and shall be assessed a \$15 administrative fee prior to the return of the electronic device.~~

Laser Pointers

Laser pointers shall be confiscated, and parents may obtain them from the principal or designee.

Disposal

Any telecommunications/electronic device in the possession of the District for 60 calendar days after confiscation shall be considered property of the District and may be disposed of according to current state law.
