Recommended Increases - District Meal Prices for 2016/17

Discussion:

A proposed increase in District Meal Prices for the **2016-17** School year is due to the Federal "Healthy Hunger-Free Kids Act" which reauthorized the National School Lunch Program. This regulation requires the District to increase meal prices to meet Federal Equity Pricing Requirements. Complying with the equity in pricing will necessitate raising all school lunch prices and milk prices by \$.10. This includes Adult Meals.

No increase is proposed for breakfast prices at all levels.

^{*}Notes: Reduced prices are set by the Federal Government. The State is currently paying the reduced breakfast and reduced lunch price, so for the 2016-17 School year this will remain the same so the district will not need to charge students who are approved for reduced meals. "
