

Activities Director Report

News/Notes:

- With the current increase in spectator limits to 250 people, we have reconfigured how we are doing ticketing for home events.
 - Fans can go to CI-RANGERS.ORG and click on the links provided to sign up to attend any remaining home basketball or wrestling events.
 - Athlete families will continue to get first priority when it comes to tickets, but we are planning to have extras left over for other fans and community members.
 - We will continue to not charge an admission fee for winter home events.

Athletics/Activities Updates:

- **Dance** – The Rangerette dance team is winding down their season and preparing for sections. At their most recent meet in Detroit Lakes, Varsity kick took 2nd and Varsity jazz took 4th. Sections are Feb. 27th in Wadena.
- **Boys Hockey** – The Lightning boys' hockey team is 9-1 on the season and ranked towards the top of their section. C-I students on the JV/Varsity hockey team include Carter Holtzleicher (Sr.), Landon Erickson (Sr.), and Gabe Windorski (Soph.).
- **Girls Hockey** – The Lightning girls' hockey team is 3-6 on the season. C-I students on the JV/Varsity team include Jaydn Wodarz (9th) and Jasmyn German (8th).
- **Wrestling** – The Ranger wrestling team is currently 7-7 as a team on the year. Sophomore John Paul Fitzpatrick is currently ranked 2nd in Class A at 138 pounds and his brother Michael is ranked 10th at 182 pounds. The team recently hosted Aitkin and Ogilvie in a triangular on Feb. 12th. The team defeated Ogilvie 45-33 before falling to Aitkin 50-18. Their last home match of the season is Feb. 20th when they host Walker and Rush City/Braham.
- **Girls Basketball** – The girls' basketball team is 7-1 on the year so far. They were undefeated until recently dropping a game at Pequot Lakes on Feb. 12th. They will look to rebound with upcoming home games against Park Rapids (Feb. 18th), Upsala (Feb. 25th), and Detroit Lakes (Feb. 26th).
- **Boys Basketball** – The boys' basketball team is 4-3 on the season. Their most recent game was a 57-51 win over Pillager on Feb. 6th.
The program is currently on pause due to COVID, but they will be back in action on Feb. 20th vs. Proctor at home and Feb. 23rd vs. Pierz, also at home.
