

Public Law 105.17, known as the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), requires that school districts provide a free and appropriate education to all disabled children and young adults from birth through 21 years of age. 


#### March 7th 5:00-6:45pm

September 1, 2016. Please bring the following items to Kindergarten Round Up: child's birth certificate and record of immunizations. If you do not have a copy of your child's birth certificate, you will need to order one from the birth state. (It can take six to eight weeks to arrive.) A copy of the birth certificate is essential before school starts in September but please come to Kindergarten Round Up to register even if you are waiting for any of the required documents.
