## Child Find for Special Education

Public Law 105.17, known as the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), requires that school districts provide a free and appropriate education to all disabled children and young adults from birth through 21 years of age. The Three Rivers School District requests assistance with the identification of any disabled children ages Birth through 21 who are not enrolled or currently being served in one of the District's schools.

## Kindergarten Launch Evergreen Elementary March 7th 5:00-6:45pm



Dear Families :

On Monday March 7th from 5:00-6:45 pm at Evergreen Elementary we will be having pizza dinner, a short meet & greet in the gym and activities for you and your child to do in the classrooms.

- \* Dinner will be served from 5:00-5:45 in the cafeteria
- \* Followed by a quick meet & greet in the gym
- \* Information flyer passed out about Kindergarten Roundup— which is coming up in May

In order to attend kindergarten next year, a child must be five years old on or before September 1, 2016. Please bring the following items to Kindergarten Round Up: **child's birth certificate and record of immunizations** . If you do not have a copy of your child's birth certificate, you will need to order one from the birth state. (It can take six to eight weeks to arrive.) A copy of the birth certificate is essential before school starts in September but please come to Kindergarten Round Up to register even if you are waiting for any of the required documents.
