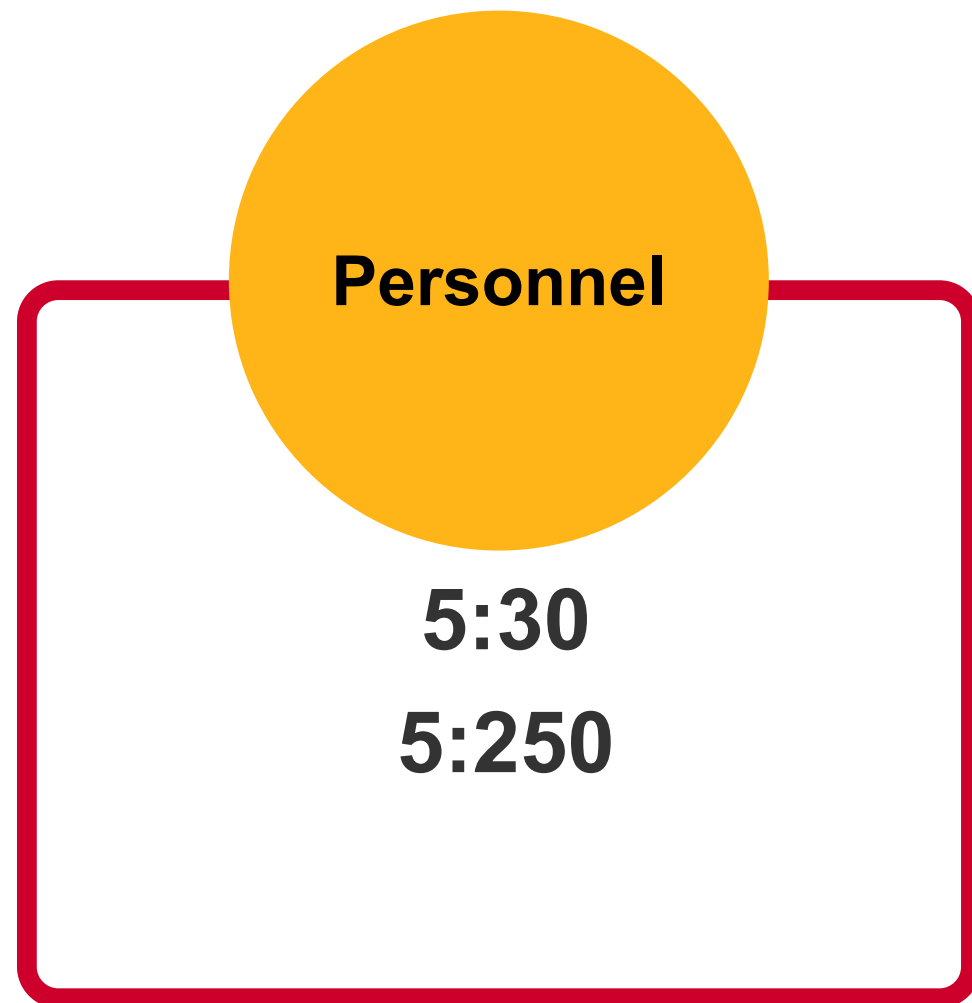

- In response to concerns regarding the impact of federal immigration enforcement on employment, the General Assembly passed P.A. 104-455 during the veto session. It adds protections for employees if their employer receives a *no match* letter from a federal agenda regarding a discrepancy in the individual's identifying documents (5:30).
- New unpaid leave entitlement for employees whose child is a patient in a neonatal intensive care unit. This leave is in addition to leave that may also be available to employees under FMLA (5:250).
