HIGH-PROGRESS SCHOOL IDENTIFICATION: A HIGH-PROGRESS SCHOOL WILL BE IDENTIFIED AS TITLE SCHOOL IN THE TOP 25% IN ANNUAL IMPROVEMENT AND/OR SCHOOL IN THE TOP 25% OF THOSE DEMONSTRATING ABILITY TO CLOSE PERFORMANCE GAPS BASED ON SYSTEM SAFEGUARDS. ANY SCHOOL THAT HAS SIGNIFICANT ACHIEVEMENT GAPS ACROSS SUBGROUPS THAT ARE NOT CLOSING WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED A REWARD SCHOOL.
