Background Information:

Aledo High School has historically offered locally developed SAT preparatory courses delivered by AHS staff. In the fall semester research was done to investigate third-party companies that can offer test prep to AHS students on our campus. Companies compared were Princeton Review, Kaplan, Revolution Prep, and Huntington Learning Center. Beginning this spring semester we will begin to conduct a test prep program in partnership with Huntington Learning Center. The courses will be either 18-hour or 28-hours in length, meeting over a period of 5 or 7 weeks. The target audience for these test prep courses will be students wishing to achieve a certain score either for admission or scholarship purposes.
