Bryant Elementary School 2019 Security Funding Proposal

Mr. Seneca G. Woodson, District Security Supervisor, presented the Bryant Elementary School 2019 Security Funding Proposal. Mr. Woodson estimated the annual total cost of this operation to \$66, 900. He stated the total annual cost will include a list of the following:

Mr. Woodson is currently in the process of completing the security assessments on the remaining schools in the district and will present their financial needs as well. In conclusion, the project will be reviewed and brought back to the Finance Committee at a later date.

Dr. Wilkinson stated that there will be a special Board Meeting on Thursday, March 7, 2019 to present the facility options recommendation once again.

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2019 Health Life Safety Renovations / Pre-Bid Meeting

Dr. Wilkinson presented to the Finance Committee 2019 Health Life Safety Renovations Pre- Bid Meeting was held on February 20, 2019. Five (5) contractors attended. The project will be occurring at (4) schools; Brooks Middle School, Bryant Elementary School, Holmes Elementary School, and Whittier Elementary School. The project consists of electrical and architectural work. Bids due date is Monday, March 11, 2019 @ 11:00a.m.

A Recommendation will be brought to the Board once all data is collected.

Student Transportation Pre-Bid Meeting

Student Transportation Pre-Bid Meeting was held on Tuesday, March 5, 2019, @ 10:00 a.m. Four (4) companies were in attendance. AllTown Bus Co. is currently the Districts transportation provider. Bids are due Tuesday, March 26, 2019 @ 10:00a.m.

Illinois Property Tax Appeal Board / Tax Objections

Dr. Wilkinson presented to the committee Ill Property Tax Appeal Board / Tax Objections. Both appeals relate to properties within the City of Markham's Dixie Highway TIF. And in each case, 86.1% of the taxes went to the TIF, so 86.1% of the refunds would come out of the TIF fund and only 13.9% of the refunds would come out of the taxing bodies. In the case of the Vitran Illinois appeal, that means that only \$3,098 in tax revenues are at risk for SD 152. Since that level of risk does not warrant the cost of fully intervening, I = John M. Izzo, Attorney, am recommending that we not intervene in the Vitran Illinois case.

But in the case of the City of Markham appeal, the amount of revenue at risk for the District is so large, even when discounted to 13.9%, at \$25,383, I=John Izzo, Attorney, am recommending intervention. The attorney states that this case is highly unusual, however, because the City of Markham, which has the bulk of the tax revenues at risk, is also the appellant. I=John Izzo, Attorney, suspect that the intervention will not involve hiring a valuation expert or a contested evidentiary hearing, but maybe some sort of discussion or even negotiation with the City over the future development of this property.

Confirmed to move forward with Attorney John Izzo's recommendations.

Federal Child Nutrition Programs - Cash Disbursements Plan Due to Potential Federal Shutdown

Dr. Wilkinson presented to the committee and stated that there may be some delays on receiving reimbursement due to the government shutdown. Mr. Rogers suggests that he keeps the committee abreast on this situation.

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Illinois Bobcats Harvey Facility Usage Request

Illinois Bobcats requested to utilize Angelou Elementary School as an option of facility usage since Brooks Middle School was not available. Nicole Wright spoke with Ms. Brown, Building Administrator, she stated that she is ok with the dates and the times they are requesting.
