<p>BARR Training for RWHS Took place on August 1 & 2nd at the Anderson Center.</p>	<p>Building Assets, Reducing Risks (BARR) This year, we will be implementing with 8th and 9th grade and plan to also implement 10-12 in 2024-2025. BARR uses eight interlocking strategies that facilitate real, meaningful relationships between adults and students. The BARR model allows teachers to focus on building relationships with students to access their strengths and areas for growth. Educators appreciate the opportunity to see the whole student, including the context of a student's life and experiences outside of the classroom. When implemented the BARR model builds intentional relationships, utilizes real-time data, and enables schools to achieve concrete outcomes for all students</p>
