Opening and Call to Order

Chair Umbarger called the regular board meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. and welcomed the guests. The group recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes of the Meeting

Chair Umbarger asked if there were additions or corrections to the minutes of the special board meeting of February 3, 2015 and the minutes of the regular board meeting of February 9, 2015. A motion to approve the minutes as presented was made by Dave Krumbein, seconded by Bob Rosselle, and approved unanimously by the board.

Correspondence/Communication

The board received correspondence from Suzanne Kennedy regarding Common Core Standards and Gay Davis pertaining to the high school girls' basketball program.

Enrollment Report

Tricia Mooney reported that the total enrollment for the district as of March 2, 2015 is 3,160. Mrs. Mooney pointed out that we are down a total of 11 students (down 2 – Grades 6-8 and down 9 – Grades 9-12) from last month.

Certified Leave Report

Tricia Mooney reviewed the certified leave activity for the month of February 2015. Mrs. Mooney reported that we are in-line with where we have been and pointed out that we are up in the family illness category due to the flu and long-term leave activity (FMLA).

PELC Heritage Language Program

Tricia Mooney announced that they have a position posted for a full-time Kindergarten Heritage Language teacher. Mrs. Mooney explained that preference will be given to individuals who are fluent in the Umatilla language and have knowledge of the history of the local tribe or in lieu of Umatilla language fluency, a candidate with an ESOL endorsement may be considered.

Smarter Balanced Achievement Levels

Laura Miltenberger reported that on January 22, 2015 the State Board of Education adopted Smarter Balanced achievement levels to be used for systems accountability purposes. She shared the achievement levels for the 2014-2015 school year for English language arts and mathematics. 2014 Graduation Rate Analysis

Superintendent Peterson stated that the actual PSD Class of 2014 cohort graduation rate was 73% (194 graduates out of 265 in the cohort). Pendleton High School's actual graduation rate was 87% (181 graduates out of 207). Of the 71 non graduates 36 students dropped out, 15 are still in school, 13 students received either a GED, an Alternative Certificate or an Extended Diploma, and 7 students were Long-Term Care and Treatment students at the Homestead Youth Lodge. Debbie McBee requested that when gathering the information for next year, a chart format be compiled for data comparisons.

School Based Mental Health Services

Superintendent Peterson shared that all the district's school counselors and the Lifeways school based mental health counselors met this morning at the district office. Pendleton School District will have three mental health counselors serving students in the district with mental, emotional, and behavioral issues through Lifeways funded by GOBHI (Greater Oregon Behavior Health, Inc.).

Safe Schools

Superintendent Peterson noted that the 'I Love You Guys' foundation will be at the IMESD March 11, 2015 providing information on safe schools. Debbie McBee is attending the 2015 PACE day – Safe and Secure Schools on Friday, April 24, 2015 in Eugene, OR.

PBIS Update

Laura Miltenberger noted that the PBIS team continues to provide support for positive behavior with different resources available for the students and teachers.

Teams from the elementary level will attend the annual Safe & Civil Schools National Conference in Portland with OCF grant funds.

Pendleton Association of Teachers

Gary Humphries reported that he attended the 5th Annual Symposium on creating the schools our students deserve on Saturday, March 7, 2015 in Salem. It was sponsored by OEA with nationally recognized leaders Dr. Rick Stiggins, Founder of the Assessment Training Institute, and Dr. Thomas Guskey, University of Kentucky Professor, discussing and addressing questions and identifying opportunities to change Oregon's system of assessment.

Oregon School Employees Association

Teri McCoy and Kelly Doherty thanked the board and administration for recognizing the Classified Employees last week with goodies delivered to each school in honor of 'Classified Appreciation Week'.
