HISTORY:

In SEISD, STAAR testing was conducted in grades 3-12 in April-May 2025. Below are the grade levels and subjects tested. Spanish testing is also available in grades 3-5.

- Mathematics in grades 3-8
- Reading in grades 3-8
- Science in grades 5 and 8
- Social Studies in grade 8
- English I and II
- U.S. History
- Algebra I
- Biology

Another part of accountability is analyzing student growth. This information compares students previous scores to the current school years scores. This is only looked at for the math and RLA exams.

RATIONALE:

STAAR/EOC is scored with 3 performance levels:

Approaches = Passing but considered below grade level. Significant interventions may be needed for success at the next grade level.

Meets = Considered to be on grade level, minimal interventions may be needed for success at the next grade level.

Masters = Considered high performance; no interventions are needed for success the subsequent year.

During the presentation you will see how each grade level performed in Spring 2025 STAAR compared to the region based on preliminary data shared by the state. The information is separated by content and language of exam for your review.
