BACKGROUND:

Administration seeks approval for participation in the Region One Education Service Center Library Services and Instructional Resources Cooperative (Co-op) for the 2025–2026 fiscal year, under Resolution No. 007/25-26. This cooperative provides cost-effective access to high-quality educational and digital resources by leveraging volume purchasing, resulting in substantial savings for the district.

Through this membership, the district gains access to a wide range of instructional tools and platforms, including:

- Discovery Education
- News-O-Matic
- MackinVia eResource Management System
- TexQuest (includes Britannica, EBSCO, Gale, Learn360, ProQuest, and TeachingBooks.net)
- Gale Presents Peterson's Test Prep

Additional benefits include professional development opportunities specifically for librarians through MegaBYTE and Region One ESC-led workshops. Continuing with the cooperative provides all services at a significantly reduced cost, resulting in total annual savings of \$937,027.36. The annual membership fee of \$3.38 per student, totaling \$121,521.14, grants districtwide access to these services. Participation supports instructional goals and college and career readiness by ensuring students, educators, and families can access quality digital content both at home and at school.
