Return to School:

School is back in session and I am happy to report that it has been a very smooth start to the year. Our WEB program has been very successful once again in helping our incoming 6th grade students transition to Middle School. The September 1st orientation day was a great way to prepare our incoming students for the start of the year. Our 8th grade volunteers did an excellent job fulfilling their roles as WEB Leaders. They led team building activities, building tours, helped students get organized, and made sure every student had a solid support group to help navigate all challenges they will face. Recent Professional Development:

This past summer our TMS Math Team attended the Stage 3 professional development for College Preparatory Mathematics (CPM). This is the final training for CPM and focused primarily on assessments. Our training was originally planned to be completed over a 3 year period that began in the 2018-19 school year. Due to the COVID shutdown, the final stage 3 training was postponed in the summer of 2020. The first training focused on course structure and classroom environments, followed by stage 2 that focused primarily on instruction practice. Our team will continue to receive support from our regional instructional coach John Hayes.

TMS Athletics: Fall sports are off to a great start. Football, Cross Country, and Volleyball are in full swing with no restrictions at this point.

2021-22 Academic & Career Planning Field Trips: The opportunities for these trips have been reduced due to the pandemic, however opportunities are beginning to open up.
