Purpose of Trip:

The MHS Interact Club would like to travel to Missouri over the Presidents Day holiday weekend with the organization Students Today, Leaders Forever on a Pay It Forward (PIF) Tour.

On this trip, students will:

- Participate in meaningful service learning
- Learn about leadership and teamwork
- Visit college campuses and learn about higher education opportunities

This will be the fourth PIF Tour that will leave MHS. Interact also traveled with STLF in 2012-2014.

Trip Itinerary: Leave MHS Thursday evening, headed toward either Kansas City or St. Louis. Making 2 stops on the way down, students would participate in service projects in each city, sleep in community centers or churches, visit a college campus, and meet with other PIF tours in the Celebration City at the end of the trip. The STLF members (college students) who chaperone the trip and lead all activities will finalize the itinerary and share it with families 1 month prior to the trip.

How it is funded: The cost is \$355/ student which includes all lodging, 2 meals/day, coach bus, and t-shirts. Students would be responsible for this cost plus one meal/day (~\$40 total). Interact will fundraise to defray costs, and STLF provides financial assistance for students who need help paying for the trip.

Transportation: Coach bus arranged by STLF
