Staff from the Division of Special Education has carefully reviewed your request which was received on March 9, 2010 from Oak Park Elementary School District 97 to expand Lincoln School and to install accessible restrooms at Holmes School and Brooks Middle School. I am pleased to inform you that we have approved your request. The costs for these projects may be included in your FY10 ARRA IDEA Part B grant applications.
