## **Background Information**

The Duncanville High School High Hats Drill Team has been invited to represent our district in the prestigious **2026 National Cherry Blossom Parade**, April 9–13, 2026, in Washington, D.C. Students will perform in the nationally televised zone and the parade's opening production, gaining broad artistic exposure while serving as ambassadors for Duncanville ISD. The itinerary also includes a rehearsal workshop, guided tours of the National Mall monuments, visits to Smithsonian museums (including the National Museum of African American History & Culture), and a farewell dinner cruise on the Potomac River—all of which provide rich cultural, historical, and civic-engagement learning experiences. Only two instructional days will be missed, and all chaperones will receive district background clearance.
