

ACES Collaborative for Regionalized Out-of-District Special Education Transportation Services

Goal: Create cost-savings for districts through a collaborative for regionalized transportation to out-of-district special education placement sites

Service: ACES will manage the provision of special education transportation services to non-ACES outplacement sites on behalf of districts.

The service will include:

- 1. collecting all necessary student information and outplacement information from the District;
- 2. developing routes for bidding out to special education transportation service providers;
- 3. brokering and contracting with those providers on behalf of the District; and
- managing those contracts on a daily basis, including fielding parent calls and concerns, adjusting routes as necessary, and communicating with outplacement sites as necessary;
- 5. hiring aides to staff all runs;
- 6. training all drivers and aides regarding students with special needs;
- 7. maintaining and supplying records to the District for the purpose of Excess Cost and Medicaid reimbursement; and
- 8. conducting orientations for parents of participating students.



2018-19 Pilot

- Start date for student transportation: Opening day of 2018-19 school year
- End date for student transportation: Final day of 2018-19 school year (ESY negotiable)
- Outplacement sites: Six pilot sites identified in collaboration with partner districts, with additional sites available upon request
- Implementation Timeline:
 - February 28, 2018 Student information for 2018-19 confirmed
 - *March 15, 2018* Proposed runs produced
 - April 6, 2018 Proposed costs shared with district partners
 - May 30, 2018 Final opt-out date for district participation
 - Summer 2018 Runs, costs and fees finalized; aides hired; drivers and aides trained
 - August 2018 Orientation for families; any needed equipment installed on vehicles and drivers trained in its use
 - Start of school year, August 2018 (specific dates may vary) Student transportation commences
 - August 2018 June 2019 ACES manages daily service
 - Quarterly (or more as needed), 2018 through 2019 Ongoing collaborative meetings among partner districts and ACES
