Trustees recognized for dedication to NTAASB

The North Texas Area Association of School Boards recently recognized the Denton ISD Board of Trustees with a \$1,000 award for its dedication to NTAASB causes and goals.

NTAASB annually awards \$1,000 and \$500 to the school boards that attend the most meetings during the school year. Meetings are held throughout Regions X and XI with trustees and superintendents earning continuing education credits for their participation while learning about various issues affecting school districts in North Texas.

Dinner and speaker fees for meetings are underwritten by corporate sponsors, membership dues and NTAASB, with no additional costs to member school districts.
