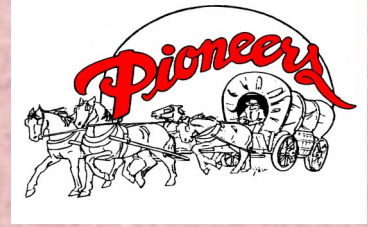

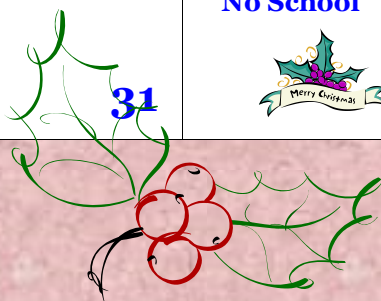

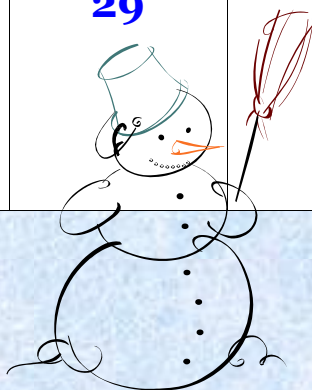

## STRINGS PROGRAM

Beginning Friday, December 5, 2017, In partnership with the Sugarloaf Community Association Williams Elementary will be offering guitar and violin lessons to students in grades 2-8th grade who are seriously interested in learning to play or have intermediate knowledge of guitar or violin. This will be offered as an afterschool program on Tuesdays. Beginning Guitar will start from 2:30-3:30, Intermediate Guitar from 3:30-4:30, and Violin from 4:30-5:30. The class requires a tuition fee of \$75.00 for the year, which includes the use of an instrument. Class will be held at Williams Elementary School and taught by professional musician Willie Warwick. The class will end in the Spring with the Strings Spring Concert. Students in the beginning guitar class will be provided with a snack and supervision until their class begins. Parents will need to provide transportation home. If your student will be attending the Violin class transportation to and from the class will need to be provided. Please return them ASAP as the class will fill up quickly.



## 2017/18 ADVERSE WEATHER CONDITIONS

### Straight Line Routes For Williams Elementary School

In the event of adverse weather conditions parents are advised to tune in to Radio Stations KRWQ, KAJQ, KLDK, KBOY and TV Stations KOBI (5), KDRV (12), KTVL (10) or the Three Rivers School District Web Page ([www.threerivers.k12.or.us](http://www.threerivers.k12.or.us)) for information on school bus schedules, delays or closures.

Sometimes weather conditions leave some roads blocked or unsafe to travel but school is still being held. Under these circumstances "straight line routes" will be run. This is the information you will get on the web page or radio/TV stations.

When straight line routes are run the roads affected are listed below. If you live on one of the roads the buses cannot travel, you may bring your student to the nearest intersection of the main road. This will also be the stop for the afternoon drop off. Exact times may vary.

#### ROUTE #

B-02 (No Service) Tetherow, Panther Gulch Road, and East Fork Rd (beyond Jct with Panther Gulch)

Snow Stops: Tetherow Rd on Williams Hwy  
Jct of Panther Gulch and East Fork Road

B-03 (No Service) Cedar Flat (beyond Jct with Kincaid Road), Caves Camp, Pine Tree Dr.

Snow Stops: Jct of Cedar Flat Rd and Kincaid Rd  
Pine Tree Dr on Water Gap Rd.

In the event of a school delay or closure you will be notified via the districts InTouch message system either by phone, text, and or email. Please make sure your contact phone numbers and email information is up to date with the school in order to receive this message.

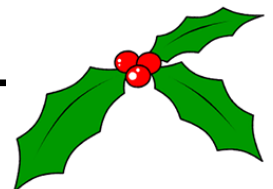


### SCHOOL AND DISTRICT REPORT CARDS
