- Marketing of the school forest-an article will be written about desks and students using the school forest-will be done by
- Building Recycling Initiatives-update: green (compost), black (trash), blue (paper), yellow (bottles and cans). Student rep will work with Doug on the best places to put the bins.
- Composting now started. Soil is hoped to be sold. Compost ranger program being created by 7th grade (student update)
- \$500 EE money donation-ideas for the money-7th grade students voted on hammocks.
- · Bird Festival May 14th, schedule went out
- EE pd for teachers on Nature Journaling given on April 23rd (part of Osprey Wilds Grant this year)
- · Animal program given to pk-4 on May 5th (part of Osprey Wilds grant this year)

 - Wish list brainstormed for solarium and EE initiatives
- White pine project
 - 5th and 6th grade students will be planting seeds with DNR in Breezy Point on May 20th.
 - New seeds have been ordered for primary students to plant by the end of the year
