Student Welfare**

Students' shall be closely supervised by MESD staff while in MESD's facilities, on MESD grounds during the hours when students are normally present and during MESD-sponsored off-campus activities. Student supervision does not include early morning or the time following usual departure, unless students are present for a scheduled MESD-sponsored activity. Hours when supervision is available shall be made known to students and parents, guardians or persons in a parental relationship.

MESD shall:

1. Maintain a safe environment;
2. Periodically inspect the physical condition of all buildings and grounds;
3. Emphasize safe practices on the part of MESD personnel and students, particularly in those areas of instruction or extracurricular activities that include known hazards;
4. Offer safety education to students germane to particular subjects including laboratory courses in science, health and physical education and activities including work sites;
5. Provide first-aid care for students in case of accident or sudden illness.

Suspicious activities or strangers shall be reported to the Superintendent or designee. The police shall be notified if warranted in the judgment of the Superintendent or designee.
