3.	afford experiences for parents/guardians of children with disabilities through a voluntee aide program whereby they can become oriented to the task of the school and how their role as parents might relate to the task as it affects their children;
4.	engage in direct service delivery in the least restrictive environment that meets the child's needs through cooperative, interagency efforts;
5.	provide training opportunities and consultative services for community agency staff that serve young children and their families; and
6.	engage in transition activities between preschool and kindergarten experience that will contribute to the child's success in school.
