

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

## Process for Responding to a Report of Bullying

#### Assess for immediate safety issues

Notify parents of the alleged victim & aggressor a report has been submitted.

Contact Parents to notify them of findings
Assign Consequences and Interventions
(Disciplinary Consequences, Counseling Referral,

(Disciplinary Consequences, Counseling Referral, Schedule Change, Behavior Contract, Stay Away Agreement, Campus Transfer).

#### **Conduct Investigation**

Follow Up: Monitor Behavior

### **Incident is reported**

#### **Initiate Action Plan**

Interview Victim

Interview Alleged Aggressor


Interview Witness(es)

Finalize within 10 Business Days and conclude whether bullying occurred.

Monitor the effectiveness of any corrective actions taken. Inquire to see if there have been any new incidents

Respond promptly to address new problems






