


Henderson ISD students in grades 7-12

Participation in the Henderson Fishing Team is strictly optional.

Henderson Fishing Team is designed and structured to promote sportsmanship, conservation awareness, safety, and educational opportunities.





 Boat Captains serve in a volunteer role, and agree to provide the use of their boat for the use of taking Henderson Fishing Team student anglers on the water during tournaments and practice.

Boat Captains must provide proof of insurance coverage according to the requirements for the tournament guidelines.

Boat Captains can not be in Middle School or High School.

Boat Captains must have graduated from high school.

The boat and the boat captain must follow the tournament guidelines and state laws for the boat requirements, fishing guidelines, and boating safety.

Attendance


Students must be in good standing with the school administrators as far as attendance is concerned. Attendance issues can prevent a student from participating in a tournament.

Report Card

A current copy of the student report card must be turned in to the Ultimate High School Fishing **Tournament before** each tournament.

Discipline

Students must be in good standing with the school administrators as far as discipline is concerned. Discipline issues can prevent a student from participating in a tournament.





PRE-FISHING Student anglers are eligible to have an excused absence on the Friday preceding the tournament date to pre-fish for the tournament.




REGULAR Season

Ultimate High School Fishing has 7 regular season tournaments on the schedule each year. LOCAL NATIONAL

Ultimate High School Fishing has 1 post season tournament each year in May.

There are various local and national tournaments the Henderson Fishing Team could qualify to participate in.





BOAT

It is the parent/student's responsibility to find/provide a boat to use for the tournaments. HISD is not responsible for providing boats.

FEES

It is the parent/student's responsibility to pay all the associated fees related to the tournaments. HISD is not responsible for paying any fees.

SPONSORSHIPS

It is the parent/student's responsibility to secure any and all sponsorships related to the tournaments. HISD is not responsible for any sponsorship fees.

• Each student angler is responsible for at least \$250 in sponsorship money to be paid to Ultimate High School Fishing for the school to be vested for the scholarship program.


 Additional sponsorships can be utilized to offset the costs for the tournaments and related fees.




The coach facilitates the excused absences, report cards, and communicates important information with team members and parents.
