Preschool Over Capacity

Three-year-old preschool is not funded by the State of Iowa and is a financial loss for BK school.

Currently, we have more three-year-olds registered for preschool than we have slots. Our maximum by law is 16, and we generally hold it to 15 in case we get a three-year-old special education student. We would be required by law to provide preschool services to a three-year-old with a special education individualized education plan (IEP).

We are already at 21 after the open house and TLC is completely full.

We have three options:

- 1. Double our sections and double our loss when our budget is on the edge. Plus, our preschool teacher does special education half days. Putting her into a preschool classroom would reduce services to our special needs students.
- 2. Do a lottery and reject half of three-year-olds.
- 3. Have all three-year-olds attend alternate days.

We are worried about turning away students and families who have expressed a desire to start school. The downside is that we might have parents change their mind if they knew we were only doing two days a week versus five.

- We could split the three-year-olds into two groups, one group on Monday-Thursday and the other Tuesday-Friday. We already cancel on early out Wednesdays so there would be fewer cancelled days.
- The Wright County preschool director has given permission to do this. We would just cut the tuition in half and apparently other schools already do this.

I recommend there be no changes in four-year-old preschool.

Hiring Update

We are currently fully staffed for the next school year. We are one of the very few in the state of Iowa.
