Dec. 2 – Report Cards are sent home – Below is the information we provided parents in order to better understand the move to a more standardized report card at the elementary level. This is an explanation of the two scales that will be seen on the report card. The first scale is the academic scale and the second scale is the life skill/behavioral scale that is connected to the Hatchet Pride expectations that we have in the elementary school.

Dear Parent/Guardians,

In an effort to better communicate your student's understanding and progress in Language Arts and Math, you will see some changes to the Tomahawk Elementary School report card. The reasoning behind the two scales is to separate the Academic Scale from the Life Skill/Behavioral Scale, in order to effectively measure student mastery. This is a movement toward a standardized report card. Our desire is for our students to have BOTH the behaviors and the master of academic learning targets to succeed. Please see the grading scales with detailed descriptions below:
