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**NSBSD Policy Manual:**

BP3270 Sale and Disposal of Books, Equipment and Supplies (Personal Property)

The School Board recognizes that the district may own personal property, which is unusable, obsolete, or no longer needed by the district and that the disposal of such property may be in the best interest of the district.

The Superintendent or designee shall identify to the Board all inventoried personal property not needed by the district, together with the estimated value and recommended disposition. With Board approval, the Superintendent or designee shall arrange for the sale or disposal of district personal property in accordance with state law.

**Issue Summary:**

The vehicles have been reviewed and determined to be no longer economical or practical to maintain in service due to age, mileage, or mechanical condition. Continued use of these vehicles presents increasing maintenance costs and reduced reliability.

**Recommendation:**

The Administration recommends approval of publicly advertised sales of District owned surplus vehicles at the earliest possible date.
