- 1.) If you plan to submit applications for possible placement of Foreign Exchange Students for the coming year In the Salt Lake City School District, this document must be notarized and returned to the Student Services Department before November 15.
- 2.) A current copy of your "Certificate of Acceptance" from the Evaluation Committee of the Council on Standards for International Educational Travel (CSIET) must accompany your affidavit.
- 3.) Your application to place students in this district requires SLCSD Board approval. A final list of approved agencies will be available in late <u>December.</u> Board approval does not guarantee the acceptance of all Foreign Exchange Student applications.
- 4.) If approved, your agency may submit student applications to the Student Services Department after <u>January 15 and not later than July 1</u>. The district may reach its quota before the July 1 deadline.
- 5.) You will be notified of student applications accepted by the district.

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Utah State Code (53G-6-707), State Board Rule (R277-612) and the Salt Lake City School District policy (S-1 - Student Admissions) require that your organization submit a sworn "Affidavit of Assurances" that the following standards have been met prior to requesting placement of Foreign Exchange Students in the Salt Lake City School District.

- 1.) Your organization/agency has been evaluated and approved by the Council on Standards for International Educational Travel (CSIET) or other documentation that ensures that your program has complied with all rules and regulations established by the US Department of State; and
- 2.) Your agency has met/will meet the following district and state requirements:
 - A household study, including a background check of all adult residents in each household where an exchange student is to reside, has been satisfactorily completed.
 - A background study assures that the exchange student will receive proper care and supervision in a safe environment.
 - Host parents have received training appropriate to their positions, including information about enhanced criminal penalties under Utah Code Subsection 76-5-406 (10) for persons who are in a position of special trust.
 - A representative of your agency shall visit each student's place of residence at least monthly during the student's stay in Utah.
 - Your agency shall cooperate with school and other public authorities to ensure that no exchange student becomes an unreasonable burden upon the district or other public agencies.
 - Each exchange student will be given in the exchange student's native language, names and telephone numbers of agency representatives and others who could be called at any time if a problem occurs.
 - Alternative placements are readily available so that no student is required to remain in a household if conditions appear to exist which unreasonably endanger the student's welfare.
- 3.) Your agency must provide the district with a <u>complete student application</u> which includes the following:
 - Personal letter from the student,
 - Detailed information on student and natural family,
 - Proof that the student has sufficient English language proficiency to function successfully in the school and classroom,
 - Original transcript of student's high school grades, with English translation that meets district requirements,
 - Necessary medical history, including proof of immunization as required by the district, any medical/physical restrictions and a recent physical exam, and
 - Proof of student's medical and accident insurance that meets or exceeds U.S.
 Department of State guidelines.
 - District cover letter (agency info, host family name, etc.)

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- 4.) Your agency understands and communicates to students and their host families the following:
 - SLCSD reserves the right of final approval on all student placements.
 - Students are expected to participate in regular classes and maintain a typical schedule, and make satisfactory academic progress.
 - The student may be enrolled in the SLCSD for one year only.
 - Students and their host families are expected to know and follow all school policies and rules.
 - Students may not be granted fee waivers or be provided transportation at District expense beyond established school bus routes.
 - Students are not eligible to receive Special Education Services or ALS Services.
 - Students will not be eligible for graduation from a SLCSD high school.
