## B. Sick Leave Bank Update

The AISD Employee Sick Leave Bank was created during the 2014-15 school year to provide employees who may wish to join an opportunity to combine their local leave days with others. The bank of days created are to be used only for catastrophic reasons outlined in the plan documents.

#### In 2014-2015:

- A total 341 employees (out of 550 total employees) joined the SLB creating a bank with a total of 682 Days
- There were three applications for withdrawals from the bank that were approved. All
  who applied were ultimately approved for an amount of withdrawal of
  - 1 30 day award
  - 1 20 day award
  - 1 10 day award
- Balance in June 2015 = 622 days

## In 2015-2016:

- Out of 63 new hires since 6/5/2015 26 have chosen to enroll in the SLB (enrollment deadline was 9-14-15)
- Current balance as of September 2015 = 674 days

# C. Enrollment Update

Enrollment has trended higher than anticipated so far this fall. The following table illustrates the enrollments of all AISD campuses through the peak enrollment date.
