## **Achievement & Integration**

## The purpose of the Achievement & Integration program is to:

- Pursue racial and economic integration
- Increase student achievement
- Create equitable educational opportunities
- Reduce academic disparities based on students' diverse racial, ethnic, and economic backgrounds in participating schools and districts



## **Achievement & Integration**

#### Plan

- Plan created every three years
- New Plan for 2020 2023
- Alignment and reporting with World's Best Workforce (WBWF)

#### Goals

- Achievement Disparity
- Integration (representation and access)
- Access to Effective, Diverse Teachers

#### **Revenue Distribution**

- Revenue is 70% state aid and 30% local levy.
  - At least 80% direct student services
  - Up to 20% professional development
  - No more than 10% admin costs



**Goal 1:** Increase four-year graduation rate from 78.5% to 90%

Achievement disparity goal
WBWF: All students graduate
Close all racial and economic achievement
gaps

#### Work aligned to Graduation

- Provide targeted, culturally responsive, career and college ready counseling
- Increase culturally responsive social-emotional and academic supports
- Strengthen implementation of Advancement Via Individual Determination (AVID) program
- Increase capacity of teachers to deliver rigorous curriculum within the AVID School Wide framework



**Goal 2:** Increase the percentage of incoming racially and economically diverse students demonstrating kindergarten readiness in pre-reading from 31.5% to 70.0%

Achievement disparity goal
WBWF: All students ready for kindergarten
Close all racial and economic achievement
gaps

#### Work aligned to Kindergarten Readiness

- Support early childhood and voluntary pre-k recruitment and registration
- Develop strong school-home partnerships
- Support student and family transition to kindergarten
- Establish PK-3 System of alignment



**Goal 3:** Decrease the disparity in representation for enrollment of students of color in rigorous high school courses from -24% to -5%

Integration (representation or access)
WBWF: All student college and career ready
Close all racial and economic achievement
gaps

#### Work aligned to Rigorous Coursework

- Support for advanced learners K-12
- Increase culturally responsive social-emotional supports
- Provide culturally responsive academic support
- Ensure equitable access to college credit bearing coursework
- Build strong school-family partnerships



**Goal 4:** The percent of students access to teachers/classrooms demonstrating culturally responsive pedagogy will increase from 46% to 75%

Teacher equity goal

#### Work aligned to Culturally Responsive Classrooms

- Increase culturally responsive social-emotional supports
- Provide culturally responsive academic support
- Increase capacity of teachers and leaders to deliver culturally responsive instruction and build inclusive school environments



## **Budget Overview**

		Budget Ratios
Direct Services to Students must equal at least 80% of total revenue	\$1,680,455	80.93%
Professional Development may equal no more than 20% of total revenue	\$212,627	10.24%
Administrative/Indirect may equal no more than 10% of total revenue	\$183,300	8.83%
Total Proposed Revenue	\$2,076,382	100%
